ABSTRACT

This paper aims at investigating students' perception on using media in instructional context. The data of this study were taken from students' perception in SMKN 1 Kendari. The data were collected by observation, learning journal reflection and coding data. The results of this study are expected to give contributions for students (1) It can attract students' attention more, so that it can stimulate learning motivation. (2) It can make students' do more learning activities because they do not only listen to teacher's explanation but also have other activities such as observing, demonstrating and so forth. There are five points which given by the researcher in reflection among them about students' responses, benefits, disadvantages, advantages, and suggestions. It is found that majority of participants felt that using media in learning English is understandable. There are only several weaknesses that need to be corrected by the teacher in using media in learning English. They also gave some suggestions to increase the quality of teaching and providing the variety of media.
